*Colorado Headwaters Land Trust (CHLT) welcomes everyone to their annual event raising money for conservation and education in Grand County.*

Fraser, CO – Colorado Headwaters Land Trust (CHLT) is holding their annual fundraiser, titled ‘A Grand Afternoon,’ on Sunday, July 21, 2019, from 12:30 – 4:30 at the B Lazy 2 Ranch and Event Venue. They are inviting everyone to attend, to learn more about the land trust and to meet the organization’s board of directors and staff. This is CHLT’s largest fundraiser of the year.

As with previous years, there will be both a live and silent auction, as well as a raffle and paddle-raiser to raise money for the land trust’s operations, projects, and conservation efforts in Grand County.
